INTRODUCTION

Gator Golf Camp is an intensive instructional camp designed to meet the needs of junior golfers of all abilities. An outstanding curriculum of practice, play and fun is planned. Campers will participate in different kinds of competition according to skill level and age with each camper completing rotations covering every phase of the game. We have brought together a great staff of golf coaches, PGA professionals, and 2009-10 University of Florida golf team members to guide the campers on their way to better golf. In addition to play and golf instruction, campers participate in intramurals, movies, and other recreational activities. The camp concludes with a camp championship to test the campers' learning experience. We are sure Gator Golf Camp will provide outstanding instruction and facilities in a serious, but fun learning environment.

In addition to the more technical aspects of the game, the Gator Golf Camp will also extensively cover the following:

 Course Management • Rules
 Mental Training Techniques • Equipment

Daytime activities include playing golf and instruction, while the evenings offer a variety of entertaining and informative seminars, including a closer look at the mental side of golf. Aspects such as visualization, self-talk, tension, anxiety, and self-doubt will be discussed.

Another interesting night-time feature will be our Player/Coaches Panel. This is a forum where we will discuss all aspects of collegiate golf. Areas covered will include academic requirements, scholarship considerations, tournaments, and the recruiting process.

Eligibility

Gator Golf Camp is open to boys and girls between the ages of 10 and 18.

Transportation

For campers traveling by air, transportation to and from the Gainesville Regional Airport will be provided. ASA (Delta Connection), US Airways and Continental serve the Gainesville Regional Airport.

Lodging

All campers will be housed in a fully air-conditioned dormitory on the University of Florida campus. If you have a roommate preference, be sure to write the name on your enrollment application as roommate assignments WILL BE MADE PRIOR TO REGISTRATION. If you do not request a specific roommate, you will be assigned one of the same age. We prefer not to change rooming assignments at registration. Campers are under constant supervision as instructors live with them in the dormitory while they are at camp. No loud music or televisions are allowed in the rooms.

SUPERVISION

Participants in the Gator Golf Camp will be supervised at all times beginning at registration. Instructors, as well as counselors, live in the dormitories with the campers. Registration will begin at 3:00 pm on the first day of camp.

Registration Procedures

Please include a \$200.00 deposit. The remainder of the balance, if any, will be due by May 9, 2010. Any applications received after May 9 must include full payment. Once an application is received, letters of acceptance are mailed, and then a final letter concerning specifics will be mailed around May 20, 2010. Registration will take place between 3:00 and 5:00 pm at the designated dorm area at the University of Florida campus. The first session of camp will end with the awards presentation at the Mark Bostick Golf Course at approximately 2:00 pm on Thursday, June 17. The second session of camp will end with the awards presentation at the Mark Bostick Golf Course at approximately 2:00 pm on Wednesday, June 23. We invite all parents to attend the awards presentations.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a \$25.00 administrative fee for early withdrawal. Any withdrawal from camp after May 9 will result in forfeiture of their \$200.00 deposit.

Insurance

The camp carries an **EXCESS** medical insurance policy to cover medical expenses for injuries/accidents that occur in the course of camp activities. Medical expenses that are declined for payment through the camper's personal insurance and/or through the excess policy become the personal responsibility of the camper's parents/guardians.

Golf Course Renovations

As home to the 2001 NCAA Champions, the golf course has gone through some major changes. On December 1, 2001, the golf course opened after a \$4 million renovation. On November 24, 2007, the golf course was renamed to the Mark Bostick Golf Course at the University of Florida. And in August 2008 the Guy Bostick Clubhouse completed a \$1.5 million renovation to update it's facilities.

I am fully aware of the risks and hazards connected with this Camp.
