Camp Directors

The TOUR Academy Junior Golf Camps at the Vanderbilt Legends Club is directed by Vanderbilt University men's and women's Head Golf Coaches Tom Shaw and Greg Allen. Tom Shaw enters his 5th season as the Head Golf Coach at VU. In 2008 he led the Commodores to their first win since 2003. Tom brought that success from Tulane University where he was the Head Coach from 2000-2006, and was named the Conference USA and Southeast Region Coach of the Year in 2006. Tom played college golf at Georgia Tech University where he was the Captain, and earned NCAA All-American honors in '90 and '91.

Greg Allen is considered one of the outstanding collegiate golf coaches in the NCAA, entering his fourth season at the helm of the Vanderbilt women's golf program. Allen came to Vanderbilt after a seven-year tenure as the head coach at the University of Arizona, where he twice won the Pac-10 Conference, finished as NCAA runner-up in 2002 and coached Lorena Ochoa, the No. 1 ranked player on the LPGA Tour, among nine other All-Americans.

First class facilities and instruction is what you can expect from the TOUR Academy Junior Golf Camp at Vanderbilt Legends Club.

Junior Overnight Golf Camps

For boys and girls, ages 10-17, all skill levels.

Price includes meals, housing, golf activities and a TOUR Academy camp amenity package.

Each student is evaluated to ensure that juniors of similar ability are grouped for instruction geared to their needs with Instructor ratio of no more than 5:1. Morning instruction rotates stations for putting, chipping, pitching, bunkers and full swing. Afternoon is on-course play with instruction staff to work on club and shot selection and course management. At the conclusion of each day, students will enjoy programming such as guest speakers, seminars, movies, field games, swimming and night golf.

Commuter Option

Enjoy everything an overnight camp has to offer, including meals, but sleep at home. Approximately 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Practice Facility

Vanderbilt Legends Club offers an exceptional instruction facility located in the heart of Tennessee, with a two-sided driving range, a short game area with two putting greens and a chipping green green.

Legends at Vanderbilt Golf Course – North Course

This par-72 course was designed by Tom Kite and Bob Cupp and is 7,190 yards from the championship tees. The course has hosted the LPGA Tour and U.S. Senior Open Qualifying. The greens are well undulated with the promise for multiple hole locations and the bunkers are large and boldly shaped.

Legends at Vanderbilt Golf Course – South Course

The second 18-hole Vanderbilt Legends Club course was also designed and built by Tom Kite and Bob Cupp. A par-71 measuring 7,100 yards, the South Course features a mix of wooded and open spaces with challenging elevation changes. The Par-4 10th hole consistently ranks as one of the most challenging in Middle Tennessee.

Accommodations

Campers will be housed two per room in the on-campus dorm rooms of Vanderbilt University. Breakfast and dinner will be served at the campus dining facilities while lunch will be provided everyday at the golf course. Campers are fully supervised 24-hours a day and may request roommates.

Camp Specifics

Campers will check-in on Sunday between 1:00 - 3:00 pm. A graduation ceremony will take place on Thursday at noon after the tournament at the Vanderbilt Legends Club Golf Course clubhouse.

- 7:00 a.m. Rise and shine, breakfast
- 8:00 a.m. Instructional skills demonstration at practice facility from staff focusing on key elements of the swing for that day
- 8:30 a.m. Instruction- campers rotate stations working on all aspects of the game
- 12:00 p.m. Lunch
- 1:00 p.m. Course play (9 to 18 holes daily). Staff to provide on course instruction and course management
- 6:00 p.m. Dinner
- 8:00 p.m. Evening activity (supervised golf and non-golf activities) movies, golf seminars, night golf, etc.
- 10:00 p.m. Lights out
