

Using the Handbook

This handbook provides information and entry forms for every junior golf tournament conducted by the KGA-PGA, Inc. In the following pages you will find important information regarding the policies and guidelines of our junior golf program. This packet is set up to be an easy resource for your use in obtaining information and registering for our many junior golf events.

Enclosed in this handbook you will find information regarding:

- Pepsi Junior Golf Tour (including Gatorade Masters and 6 Hole Divisions)
- Mountain Dew Junior Series (including Bluegrass Junior Championships & Team Championship)
- Aquafina Junior Series

- An entry form for the Kentucky Golf Association's Father/Child Championship
- Information regarding the USGA Junior Amateur Championship and the USGA Girls' Junior Championship

We will continue to provide online registration on our website, *kygolf.org* (click on the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour logo), as this has proved to be an easy and effective way to register for events. Specific directions on how to become a member and apply for a tournament are located later in the handbook.

The website will be updated each week to provide you with the latest information available, including tournament pairings and results as well as the point standings.

History

The Kentucky Golf Association was organized at a meeting at Louisville Country Club in 1911, in which officials from eight golf clubs from across Kentucky came together with the purpose of identifying a method in which to determine a champion amateur golfer for the year. From these origins came the Kentucky Golf Association, which is recognized as Kentucky's governing body for amateur golf. Officially incorporated in 1946, the Kentucky Golf Association has grown from the original eight clubs to include approximately 200 member facilities across Kentucky, and determining an amateur golf champion for Kentucky remains a primary focus. Among the services provided by the Kentucky Golf Association to its member facilities are a uniform USGA Handicap[®] computation service; USGA Course Rating[®] services, Rules of Golf administration, amateur status administration, and the conduct of state championships, including the Kentucky State Amateur Championship, which traces its origins to the Kentucky Golf Association's founding year of 1911. The association is governed by a board of directors, consisting of representatives from member facilities from ten designated sections across Kentucky.



The Kentucky Section PGA is one of the PGA of America's 41 sections, and the boundaries for the Kentucky Section coincide with the official boundaries for the State of Kentucky. The Kentucky Section PGA traces its origins to the 1925, and was officially incorporated in 1970. Today, the Kentucky Section consists of over 300 PGA Members and Apprentices from across Kentucky. These PGA Professionals perform a variety of roles (golf professionals, teachers, coaches, golf course superintendents, golf course owners/operators, administrators, sales professionals, executive management, etc.) in the game, and each are dedicated to promoting, teaching, and growing the game.



In 1978, these two organizations came together to form KGA-PGA, Inc., a joint management effort in which both organizations agreed to share staff and resources. This type of cooperation between amateur and professional golf organizations was almost unheard of, and today, only two states, Kentucky included, have this type of structure in place. The KGA-PGA, Inc. has spawned a number of initiatives since its creation in 1978, including the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame in 1984. In 1993, the two organizations worked to form a statewide junior golf tour, known today as the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour. Since its inception, this effort has reached thousands of young people from across Kentucky, and the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour has grown to include the Mountain Dew Junior Series, and the Aquafina Junior Series.

In 2002, the Kentucky Golf Association and Kentucky Section PGA came together in another joint effort to form the Kentucky Golf Foundation, with a primary purpose of constructing Golf House Kentucky, which would serve as the home for Kentucky's family of golf organizations and the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame. Completed in late 2006, Golf House Kentucky serves these purposes in a beautiful setting near Persimmon Ridge Golf Club.

2011 Pepsi Kentucky Junior Golf Program



PEPSI JUNIOR GOLF TOUR

Consists of 26 stroke play events with a year-end stroke play Tournament of Champions to be held July 25-26 at Oxmoor Country Club.

- AGES:** These events are for junior golfers 18 & under as of July 26, 2011 (the last day of the Tournament of Champions). Age divisions are based on age of junior golfer as of July 26, 2011.
- # OF HOLES:** All golfers will play eighteen holes *except:*
- Boys and Girls 12 & under will play nine holes
 - At 11 select locations, Girls 9 & under and Boys 8 & under will play six holes (can play in a maximum of 8 events)
- MAX EVENTS:** Players may play in a maximum of 14 events on the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour (8 events for those in the 6 Hole Division)
- COSTS:** \$47.50 – 18 holes, \$37.50 – 9 holes, or \$27.50 – 6 holes / per tournament. *(based on age divisions and does not include membership fee)*



GATORADE MASTERS DIVISION

Consists of 12 stroke play events as part of the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour for players with advanced skill.

- AGES:** Players must be 13 by the final day of the Tournament of Champions (July 26) and cannot turn 19 prior to the last day of the Tournament of Champions.
- # OF HOLES:** All golfers will play eighteen holes
- MAX EVENTS:** Players may play in a maximum of 10 events
- COSTS:** \$47.50 per tournament *(Does not include membership fee)*

AQUAFINA JUNIOR SERIES

Consists of 9 stroke play events.

- AGES:** These events are for junior golfers 12 & under as of the tournament date. Age divisions are based on age of junior golfer as of the tournament date.
- # OF HOLES:** All golfers will play nine holes
- MAX EVENTS:** Players may play in as many events as they wish
- COSTS:** \$40 per tournament

MOUNTAIN DEW JUNIOR SERIES

Consists of 3 stroke play events as well as the 5th Annual Team Championship (Saturday, April 9), the Spring Mountain Dew Bluegrass Junior Championship (May 21-22), and the Fall Mountain Dew Bluegrass Junior Championship (October 15-16).

- AGES:** These events are for junior golfers ages 13 – 18 as of the tournament date. Age divisions are based on age of junior golfer as of the tournament date
- # OF HOLES:** All golfers will play eighteen holes
- MAX EVENTS:** Players may play in as many events as they wish
- COSTS:** \$60 per tournament (\$150 each for Bluegrass Junior Championships)

KGA-PGA, Inc. Junior Championships and Qualifiers

ELIGIBILITY: The Championships listed below are open to any junior golfer who is a resident of the state of Kentucky. More information regarding the 2011 Kentucky Boys and Girls Junior Amateur Championships are on pages 27 and 28 respectively. More information about the 2011 Junior PGA Championship Qualifier will be available on the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour website in February.

2011 KENTUCKY JUNIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

The Kentucky Junior Amateur will be held July 6-7, 2011

- Boys 14 & under as of July 7, 2011 will play at My Old Kentucky Home Golf Course in Bardstown
- Boys 15 – 18 as of July 7, 2011 will play at Lindsey Golf Course on the base of Fort Knox
- Entry is open to any male who is 18 & under as of July 7, 2011 (the second day of the championship)
- \$90 entry fee

2010 Champions: Jay Kirchdorfer (10 & under), Matthew Liston (11-12), Tyler McDaniel (13-14), Blake Pendergrass (15-16), and Kyle Wilshire (17-18)

Overall Champion: Kyle Wilshire

2011 KENTUCKY GIRLS JUNIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

The Kentucky Girls Junior Amateur will be held July 6-7, 2011 at Bardstown Country Club at Maywood

- Entry is open to any female who is 18 & under as of July 7, 2011 (the second day of the championship)
- \$90 entry fee

JUNIOR PGA CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER

The Junior PGA Championship Qualifier will be held June 22-23, 2011 at Bardstown Country Club at Maywood

- This event is a qualifying event for the Junior PGA Championship that will be held at Sycamore Hills Country Club on August 2-5, 2011 (Tuesday – Friday) in Ft. Wayne, Indiana
- Age groups for this event are based on the age of the junior as of June 23 and are: 12 & under, 13–15, and 16–18
- For eligibility requirements visit pga.com/home/juniors/index.cfm or contact the PGA at (561) 624-8592
- Only participants playing 36 holes from the Championship Tees will be eligible for Qualifying for the Junior PGA Championship in Fort Wayne, IN
- \$50 entry fee (\$40 for participants 12 & under)

Make sure to thoroughly read over all policies as some have changed from previous years.

Registration

HOW TO ENTER: Entries for tournaments will **NOT** be accepted before **Monday, January 31, 2011**. Web registration is the easiest way to register and will be available beginning at 10:00 a.m. EST.

*For the **Pepsi Junior Golf Tour**, age divisions are based on the age of the junior as of July 26, 2011 and they will compete in that age group for the duration of the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour season. Age divisions for the **Aquafina and Mountain Dew Junior Series** are based on the age of the junior as of the day of the tournament.*

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE (please have your customer ID number ready*):

- Go to *kygolf.org* and select the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour icon.
- Click on the “Registration” tab that is located on the top bar of the page.
- Select “Click Here for Online Registration”.

HOW TO OBTAIN A CUSTOMER ID NUMBER:

- After selecting the “Click Here for Online Registration” link, scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the red link at the bottom of the page.

** If you have never competed in a KGA-PGA, Inc. tournament, you will not have a customer ID number. Follow the directions below to get a Customer ID number. **Please do not create a new account if you have played before. Call Golf House Kentucky (502) 243-8295 and we will retrieve the information for you.***

HOW TO REGISTER BY MAIL:

- Completely fill out the registration application and mark the appropriate tournaments you wish to play in.
 - Be sure to provide alternate tournaments (only for the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour) in case your first selections are full.

Entries by mail should be submitted early enough to allow ample time for possible delay or error in transmission. The risk of delay or error in transmission lies solely with the entrant.

NOTES ABOUT REGISTRATION:

- Entries for Championships will be confirmed by email only ***please provide a correct email address.***
- Membership entries for the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour will be confirmed via the membership packet sent on **Friday, May 6, 2011.**
- Registrations for any of the Pepsi Memberships are a one-time action. Once you register and check out of these you cannot go back and make changes to your tournament schedule online. If you wish to make changes you must contact Golf House Kentucky. (This does not apply to events where membership is not needed. For example, Aquafina and Mountain Dew events)
- ***Telephone and Fax entries will NOT be accepted, no matter the circumstance.***

DEADLINES: There is no Pepsi Junior Golf Tour membership deadline. However, if you sign up for membership after the Priority Deadline (April 30th, 2011), there will be an additional \$10 charge per tournament. Players may sign up for Pepsi Junior Golf Tour, Aquafina Junior Series and Mountain Dew Junior Series tournaments as the season progresses. There are, however, individual tournament deadlines that will be upheld. ***All tournament deadlines will be 5:00 p.m. est, TEN (10) days prior to the event. Seven (7) days before the event the starting times will be released and posted on the website.***

LATE ADDITIONS: If, between the time when the tournament field has been set and FORTY EIGHT (48) hours prior to the start of the event, there is an open spot in a particular starting time due to a withdrawal, it will be filled on a case-by-case basis. If a player has not signed up for the tournament prior to the deadline and notices an open spot in his/her division they may contact Golf House Kentucky and we will make every effort to ensure the player has a chance to compete. However, if it is within FORTY EIGHT (48) hours of the first tee time for the scheduled event, open spots will be left empty.

WAITING LIST: If a tournament reaches its maximum capacity before the tournament deadline, a waiting list will be established. If a spot becomes available, the first player off the waiting list will be added to the event. However, if starting times have already been established (within 7 days prior to the event) spots will be filled on a division basis. For example, if a player in the Boys 16-18 Division withdraws from the event, the first player *in that same division on the waiting list will be added to the event.* If there are no more in that division from the waiting list, the open spot will not be filled.

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be granted to participants whose requests are received via a phone call, voicemail, e-mail, or written letter to Golf House Kentucky at least **FORTY EIGHT (48)** hours prior to the scheduled event. All refunds will be issued at the end of the tournament season. If you have registered for the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour, the membership fee is non-refundable. *Refunds for the Kentucky Junior Amateur Championship and the PGA Junior Championship will not be given after the deadline date.*

WITHDRAWALS / CHANGES: Participants **MUST** notify Golf House Kentucky at least **FORTY EIGHT (48)** hours prior to the tournament if they wish to withdraw or make a change to a tournament that is not full. A player failing to properly withdraw from a tournament and/or not showing up will forfeit the entry fee and will be considered a “no show” and may be suspended from the next tournament. Any subsequent violation of this policy will result in suspension from KGA-PGA, Inc. events.

In the event of an extreme circumstance for which the participant cannot compete in the tournament within FORTY EIGHT (48) hours prior to the start of the tournament, contact Golf House Kentucky immediately. Each situation will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

Weather

In anticipation of inclement weather, the KGA-PGA, Inc. reserves the right to reduce the number of holes in a stipulated round. Such a reduction would be announced prior to the start of the round.

If an event is a total rainout an attempt will be made to:

- a) Reschedule the event
- b) Place all players in another event
- c) Give refunds to participants

Spectators

Spectators are encouraged to attend all events. However, they must be courteous to all competitors and abide by all rules set in place by the KGA-PGA, Inc. and the host facility. It is the player's responsibility to keep spectators away. Please come to the course and enjoy watching the juniors compete on their own. Spectator carts and fees are at the discretion of the host facility. Rules for spectators are as follows:

1. Spectator carts will be allowed, when available, from the host facility. All carts are to remain on the provided paths – no exceptions. In the event there are no paths provided, carts should be at least 5 feet from the fairway cut of the hole being played. Spectators will respect the entire field of participants and stop all cart movement while a player is preparing to, or in the process of making a stroke.

a. VIOLATION OF THIS POLICY:

- i. First offense – Warning
 - ii. Second offense – Forfeit of the use of the cart for the remainder of the round, without refund.
2. Only staff members from the KGA-PGA, Inc. will give rulings to the participants, at the request of the individual. The staff is there to assist in any way possible.
 3. Only participants in the event will be allowed to walk in the fairways. Spectators should remain off all teeing areas and putting greens. Spectators should remain at least 30 yards from the players at all times. *Exception: If the player requests food, drink, or anything for personal safety, then a spectator may approach a participant to deliver what was requested. The spectator should then leave the area immediately and allow the player to continue his/her play.*

a. VIOLATIONS OF THIS POLICY:

- i. First offense – Warning
 - ii. Second offense – Spectator will be asked to go into the clubhouse for the remainder of the round.
4. Spectators should turn their cellular device to silent or vibrate for the entire round. When making calls please be courteous to our golfers.

Refreshments

Participants need to remember they are playing golf when the heat index is often very high. They need to be sure to have enough liquid in their bag to last for at least nine holes. Refreshment coolers on the course are constantly checked and refilled, with every effort made to have refreshments on hand. *To ensure players have enough fluids, refreshments are intended for participants only.*

Pace of Play

The Rules of Golf require that a player shall at all times play without undue delay. The administration of pace of play will be handled by the Rules Committee of the KGA-PGA, Inc. Any appeal of a penalty must be referred to the designated tournament director of the event immediately upon completion of the round and ***HIS/HER DECISION IS FINAL.***

OVERALL TIME PAR: Groups will be required to play at a pace of 4 hours and 30 minutes for a round of 18 holes (15 minutes per hole).

OUT OF POSITION: The first group of the day will be considered out of position if it goes over the allotted time per hole listed below. Any other group will be considered out of position if, at any time during the round, the group is:

- a) Behind the prescribed schedule as detailed on the Pace of Play Time Chart below **AND**
- b) Doesn't meet the requirements of one of the following:
 - a. Reach the tee of a par 3 hole before the preceding group has cleared the next tee, or
 - b. Clears the tee of a par 4 hole before the preceding group clears the putting green of that hole, or
 - c. Arrives at the tee of a par 5 hole when the preceding group is on the putting green.

Both (a) and (b) must apply for the group to be out of position.

PACE OF PLAY PENALTIES: The following are the penalties, in sequence, for any player in a group out of position who takes more than 45 seconds to play a stroke if it is their turn to play:

- One bad time of 45 seconds or more – Warning
- A second bad time – 1 stroke penalty
- A third bad time – 2 stroke penalty
- A fourth bad time – Disqualification

RULINGS OR OTHER INCIDENTS: If a ruling or some other legitimate delay occurs which causes the group in question to lose its position, that group is expected to regain its position within a reasonable time.

TIPS TO IMPROVE PACE OF PLAY:

- Show identifying marks on your golf ball to fellow competitors.
- Get your yardage before it is your turn to play.
- Read your putt before it is your turn to play.
- Recognize when someone will need the flag tended or your ball marked.
- Get to your next shot without delay. It is more important what you do between shots than during.
- Be aware of who is away. If you aren't sure, ask.
- Know where your group is in relation to the group in front of you.
- Anyone can search for a lost ball. Have your parents and spectators one shot ahead of your group to spot errant shots.
- If a ball is not found after a brief search, the fellow competitors should go forward and play their shots to the green and let the player and spectators continue the search.
- If your ball might be lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds, play a Provisional Ball (Rule 27-2).
- If a situation arises and you do not know how to proceed, play a second ball under Rule 3-3 and continue play (stroke play only). ***You must report the facts of the situation to the KGA-PGA, Inc. staff afterwards regardless of score.***
- Place golf bag off the putting green near the next teeing ground.
- After a hole, clear the green efficiently and record scores on the next teeing ground.

Caddies

CADDIES ARE PERMITTED SOLELY AT THESE EVENTS:

- USGA Junior Amateur Qualifying
- USGA Girls Junior Amateur Qualifying
- 6 Hole Division (Pepsi Junior Golf Tour)

Exception: A player with a physical disability may request an exemption from this policy from the Director, Junior & Senior Golf with the KGA-PGA, Inc.

PULL CARTS: Pull carts are acceptable (as permitted by the host facility).

Dress Code & Conduct Guidelines

Teaching sportsmanship, etiquette, and the Rules of Golf are a primary goal of the KGA-PGA, Inc. To promote these ideals and to maintain the integrity of this program, the following guidelines for dress and conduct will apply. Tournament officials will enforce these guidelines at all KGA-PGA, Inc. junior golf events.

DRESS CODE: Proper dress is required at all KGA-PGA, Inc. event. Boys collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn *and tucked* in at all times. Girls shirts without a collar must have sleeves and fashion shirts worn untucked must NOT rise above the belt line at any time during the golf swing. Girls shorts MUST be of fingertip length. All hats or visors must be worn with the brim forward. No denim pants/shorts or cut-offs are permitted. Only girls are allowed to have visible piercings and only on the ears.

If a player breaks any part of the dress code policy, a KGA-PGA, Inc. staff member will ask them to change. Players will not be allowed to compete in the tournament if they do not adhere to the dress code policy.

CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATIONS: Any conduct which may be detrimental to the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour will not be tolerated, this includes: swearing, club throwing, or damage to the golf course or another players belongings. The first such instance of any of these actions may result in a warning, stroke penalty, or immediate disqualification.

Possession of alcohol or tobacco products, gambling, or display of vulgar or abusive behavior will result in immediate disqualification. Multiple violations will result in dismissal from the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour.

Electronic Devices

- Participants are prohibited from using electronic devices on the golf course. Electronic devices include, but are not limited to MP3 players, cellular telephones, and distance measuring devices.
- Parents and spectators are required to turn cell phones to silent or vibrate while on the golf course.
- Distance Measuring Devices are not allowed on any part of the golf course during the stipulated round by either participants or spectators.

The use of a prohibited electronic device during the stipulated round will result in immediate disqualification

GHIN Handicap Service

The KGA-PGA, Inc.'s junior golf program does not conduct any events using the GHIN Handicap system. We do however; provide the members of the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour with a GHIN number. To apply for entry into any USGA event, a golfer must have a GHIN number in order to register. By having a GHIN number, golfers are able to go to any course and compete competitively and fairly against one another.

Posting scores into the GHIN System is a great habit to form at a young age. The KGA-PGA, Inc. recommends posting every round you play so that your Handicap Index is calculated properly. For more information regarding the GHIN Handicap System visit *ghin.com*. To inquire about how you can receive a GHIN number, ask your local PGA professional or golf course manager.

Care for the Course

All players are expected to maintain the condition of the golf course by repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, replacing divots, picking up and properly disposing of trash, etc. ***Any abuse to the course or other club facilities will result in disqualification and suspension for one event.*** All players and parents are encouraged to thank the host club, staff, and volunteers for their generous support of junior golf. Thank you notes to the host facilities are greatly appreciated.

Rules of Play

The 2010 – 2011 USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play. Supplemental rules of play will be provided (if needed) at each site.

Cheating

Rules violations will be administered by the on-site tournament officials and as prescribed by the USGA Rules of Golf, KGA-PGA, Inc. Director of Junior & Senior Golf, and Executive Director. Cheating will ***not*** be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification from the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour or the Aquafina and Mountain Dew Junior Series with no refund.

Scoring Limit

Although it is meant to be an enjoyable learning experience for everyone involved in our junior golf tournaments, there is a high level of competitiveness. For that reason, and to help maintain a reasonable pace of play, the KGA-PGA, Inc. has deemed it necessary to implement the following policy. The policy is not in effect to discourage junior golfers, it is meant to provide a competitive atmosphere and experience.

Any player who scores over the posted limit for his/her age at two different events will be suspect to review and dismissal from the remainder of the tour/series schedule. All remaining fees shall be refunded.

Keeping Score

Rule 6-6a in the USGA Rules of Golf states: “After each hole the marker should check the score with the competitor and record it. On completion of the round the marker shall sign the card and hand it to the competitor.”

Rule 6-6d in the USGA Rules of Golf states: “The competitor is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole on his card. If he returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken, he shall be disqualified. If he returns a score for any hole higher than actually taken, the score as returned shall stand.”

DON'T JUST LOOK AT THE FINAL SCORE: BE SURE THAT YOUR HOLE-BY-HOLE SCORE IS CORRECT! The Committee will take care of adding the score for you.

Playoff Procedure

Time and weather permitting, all ties for first place will be decided by a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff. All ties for second will be decided by a scorecard play-off using the USGA recommended method of matching scorecards.

2011 KGA-PGA, Inc. Pepsi Junior Golf Program Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the easiest way to get in touch with Ryan and/or Andy during the tournament season?

Communication via e-mail is not only the easiest, but preferred. Ryan Tahara (rtahara@pgahq.com); Andy Ziegler (aziegler@pgahq.com)

2. Do I still have to fill out and send in the Medical Authorization Form if I am only playing in one tournament?

Yes. All participants, in any KGA-PGA, Inc. junior golf event, MUST submit the form in writing or fax (502) 243-9266 to Golf House Kentucky.

3. I am not receiving correspondence, information and confirmation about tournaments I have registered for, what do I need to do.

As noted above, most communication is done via e-mail during the tournament season, so please contact Ryan or Andy via e-mail or call Golf House Kentucky (502) 243-8295 to assure that we have a current and correct e-mail address on file for you.

4. How do I schedule a practice round prior to an event?

We do our best to provide you with information and junior rates for each course that we have a tournament at. In order to schedule a time, contact the host golf course/facility. Practice round availability, restrictions, and limitations are at the sole discretion of the host golf course/facility.

5. Can I use distance measuring/electronic devices (cell/smart phones, laser range finders, SkyCaddies, Bushnells, etc.) in KGA-PGA, Inc. junior golf events?

No. Distance measuring/electronic devices are not permitted on the golf course at KGA-PGA, Inc. junior golf events, and are strictly prohibited and enforced with a penalty of immediate disqualification.

6. Do I have to pay a membership fee to play in all KGA-PGA, Inc. junior golf events?

No. Membership fees only apply to the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour (including Gatorade and 6 Hole Divisions). All other events do not require a membership fee, only the tournament fee.

7. If I am a member of the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour and begin the season as a 14 year old and turn 15 by July 26, 2011. What age division will I play in for the season?

Whatever age you will be on July 26, 2011 is the age group that you will play in for the duration of the season. This is the same for the 6 Hole and 9 Hole Division. If you are a boy and will be 9 years old by July 26, 2011 you will not be able to compete in the 6 Hole Division.

Note: *The July 26, 2011 age requirement is only in place for the Pepsi Junior Golf Tour. Age divisions for the Aquafina and Mountain Dew Junior Series are based on the age of the junior on the day of the tournament.*

8. Can I communicate with my son/daughter during the stipulated round of a tournament?

Yes, but only to provide them with a beverage and/or food item at their request (exception: emergency situations). Please make an effort to stay at least 30 yards from all competitors, out of fairways, clear of putting greens, keeping spectator carts (if applicable) on designated paths (or ample distance from fairways in absence of paths), at all times.

9. If I want to rent a spectator cart, how do I go about doing so? How much does it cost?

As with practice rounds, we will do our best to provide information online about spectator cart availability and accompanying fees. These fees are at the sole discretion of the host golf course/facility and may vary from site to site. You can inquire about rental in the golf shop/clubhouse at most facilities.

10. If I find it necessary to withdraw from a tournament during the stipulated round, how should I go about doing so?

Please find a KGA-PGA, Inc. staff member, rules official, or intern immediately to inform them of your decision, and they will walk you through the process of exchanging/signing scorecards with fellow competitors prior to your exit from the golf course. You must sign for the scores you have recorded as a marker up until that point and assure that you return your scorecard to the scoring area, or have one of your fellow competitors do so. Also, the card you were keeping must be kept by another member of your pairing/group and if necessary cards must be exchanged so that no competitor is keeping their own score.
